The following is an update of projects and activities for your information

- 1) Road Repair-Lynch paving has completed Uxbridge Road from Central Turnpike to Mendon Road, Old Providence Road, Welsh Road, and Eight Lots Rd from Boston Road to W. Sutton Rd. We have some additional material that we purchased under this Contract our plan is to pave a small section of Boston Road from Boston Road Animal Hospital westerly towards the center. We only overlaid this bad section to ease the impact on drivers. Our plan is to add a sewer line from the villas to the center of town. If we overlaid the entire section it would be very costly and when sewer is installed it would require redoing the road.
- 2) Lake Singletary treatment-Lake Singletary will be chemically treated to control growth and nuisance aquatic vegetation on Thursday, July 27, 2017. The beach at Marion's camp and swim lessons are canceled for the day. The beach will reopen on Friday, July 28 for regular hours.
- 3) Boiler Project for the ELC-bids are due August 3rd.
- 4) Goddard Lodge Rehab-bid opening is Thursday, July 27 at 10 AM.
