

MARION'S CAMP
BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS – 2011

In order to enable the public to enjoy the recreational facilities at the Town Beach on Singletary Lake within the Town of Sutton, the Recreation Committee has adopted the following rules and regulations.

- Beach officials shall be obeyed at all times.
- No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on the beaches or in the parking area at any time.
- Children (12) years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult or person responsible for his or her behavior within the beach area.
- No rubbish or garbage shall be discarded on beaches or landing areas. Please be courteous and pack out what you bring in.
- Ball playing, tossing of Frisbees or other objects, flying kites, or other wide ranging activities shall be permitted only with the express condition of beach attendants in such areas designated by them.
- Use of rafts, inflatables, etc may be prohibited at the discretion of beach attendants.
- No boating, fishing, scuba diving shall be permitted in areas designated as swimming areas. Nor shall people engaging in these activities enter into the swim area.
- Open fires are not permitted on the beach.
- No person shall cut, break, remove, deface, defile, or misuse any structure, fence, and sign or remove any thereof. Growing trees, bushes, plants and flowers shall not be defaced, defiled or cut.
- Horseplay, foul language and crude behavior of any kind will not be tolerated.
- No animals or pets will be permitted on the beach.
- No smoking is allowed on the beach at any time.
- Fishing is not allowed from the dock during beach hours.
- Access to the beach from the water by boat, Jet Ski, or motorized watercraft is prohibited.
- Violations of above rules may result in loss of beach privileges, fines or criminal prosecution.

Parking - All Parking at the Sutton Town Beach is at vehicle owner's risk

These rules and regulations are intended to promote the safety and convenience of all who use the facilities at the Town Beach on Singletary Lake, as well as allow for maximum use of our parking area. These parking regulations will be strictly enforced. Sanctions include ticketing, towing and revocation of parking privileges.

- Vehicles must park at the Town Beach only during posted hours and in designated areas
- Vehicles must leave promptly at closing time

Any person wishing to park a vehicle at the Town Beach and use the facilities must obtain a Town Beach Permit. Permits for the Town Beach may be purchased at the Sutton Town Hall during normal business hours, on-line or at the beach during normal beach hours. Permits for beach usage are valid for the current season only. Permits will be issued in accordance with the provisions listed below and must be presented to the attending lifeguards when visiting the beach.

All patrons must follow ANY directions given by the lifeguards on duty, the Sutton Recreation Committee or any other staff at the Town Beach.

Sutton Resident Fee	\$25.00 per family of 6 (2 Adults, 4 children)
Millbury Resident Fee	\$50.00 per family of 6 (2 Adults, 4 children)
Non-Resident Fee	\$75.00 per family of 6 (2 Adults, 4 children)
Single day passes	\$5.00/person
Bus/Mini-Bus	\$100.00
Single day passes	\$5.00/person
Large Groups* (more than 10)	\$5.00/person

*Large groups must call Recreation at (508) 865-8732 or notify the attending lifeguard at least one day prior to visit.

The Town Beach opens Father's Day Weekend and closes Labor Day. Beach hours are noon-6pm daily (weather permitting).
The Town Beach is closed to the public during swim lessons **Sorry no refunds**
