**Local Upgrades/Variances**: 9 Silverledge Drive- Steve Donatelli states that they are looking for a local variance to the town regulation, they are looking to be 92 feet from the wetlands, Title 5 states only 50 feet is required, but local regulations wants 100 feet. **COVID-19** Update: Cheryl Rawinski states COVID-19 has kept them extremely busy; the town is in the red as of last week, the cases are very high with about 60 active cases. Cheryl states that some people have been uncooperative when trying to educate residents and stop the spread.

She is hoping for a conditional water supply certificate with the criteria that it would only be used for showering and laundry, any water-use for cooking and drinking would be filtered. Dottie states that she is in the middle of a sale of the house but cannot close unless she gets the conditional water supply certificate and occupancy permit following it. After much discussion, Ken Malo makes a motion to deny the conditional water supply, given there are too many variables in the situation, seconded by Tammi Marois.
