Dear Jen,

In preparation for the Planning Board meeting Monday evening, please see Joe Perreault's forwarded email as it relates to his professional option as a landscaper. Please also see the attached documents:

The 1st photo shows a representative section of the land area that we had to work with. The width is only 42".

The 2nd photo shows the distance between the plants, which were planted 3' apart to allow room for growth.

The 3rd photo shows that there is barely 9" from the edge of the plants to the curb on the pavement side.

The 4th photo shows that there less than 1 ' from the edge of the back of the plants to the adjacent property.

Joe also said that the plants will grow 9-12" on all sides within the 1st year. Therefore after 1 year, the plants will be at, or very close to the adjacent property and the curb/pavement (from the front and back). Because we had room to space the plants 3' apart they have enough room to grow and fill in as they should.

The staggered plan was done by myself, for the benefit of the pink flowered plants (Wigelia) being staggered in front of the dark green Laurel/Holly. This was from the perspective of design. When approved by the Planning Board, we all overlooked the actual physical space requirements to implement that plan.

This is the information we'll review at the meeting.

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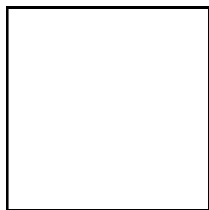
