MODIFICATION OF A SPECIAL PERMIT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

REQUIRED SUBMISSION MATERIALS:

Applications must be submitted in a complete packet in order to schedule a public hearing (please see deadlines for meeting dates).

- A completely filled out Application for Modification of a Special Permit and any supporting documents 7 copies
- A list of any waiver requests 7 copies
- Required plans 3 full sized copies
- Drainage calculations and other specialized studies if required 2 copies
- An electronic file of the Application and supporting documents
- A full sized hard copy and an electronic copy of all filing materials must be filed directly with the Town's consulting engineer (if applicable)
- Certified Abutters List from Assessors (form attached - please file with Assessors Office 10 days before application is to be submitted)
- Application and mailing fees (to be calculated by the Planning Department) make check payable to Town of Sutton
- Advertising fee

Please note: Minor modifications may not warrant an additional public hearing. A determination shall be made within twenty-one (21) days of receipt of written request and plans.
