## Comments:

Graves Engineering, Inc. (GEI) was on-site to observe the gravel base for the western parking lot at Building 3. This site visit was conducted throughout the entire site. I observed the following:

### General:

- A twenty-foot-wide area of dense-grade crushed stone had been placed and compacted along the eastern side of Building 3.
- Electric conduit had been installed from the pump house towards Building 3. The contractor was further excavating the utility trench.
- The contractor continued work on Building 3.

#### Drainage:

- Drain Manholes (DMHs) 500 and 807 had been installed and partially backfilled.
- From DMH 807 towards DMH 807A, approximately 50 feet of 18-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) had been
  installed. The 34 feet closest to DMH 807 was backfilled, while the remaining portion was covered in threequarter-inch crushed stone.
- From DMH 500 towards DMH 501, an indeterminate length of 15-inch RCP had been installed and backfilled.
- The contractor installed an additional 8 feet of 18-inch RCP between DMH 807 and DMH 807A in a satisfactory
  manner. The pipe was placed on bedding material consisting of three-quarter-inch crushed stone. The contractor
  covered and chinked the pipe with three-quarter-inch crushed stone before beginning to further excavate the
  utility trench.

Based upon visual observations only, the work observed today appeared to be consistent with the approved plans.
