

Comment 19: The fire department's largest vehicle should be able to traverse the site. It was recommended that AutoTurn (or a similar program) be used to show a swept-path analysis of the largest fire truck to be used around the site. It was also recommended that the proponent coordinate with the Sutton Fire Department regarding accessibility to all sides of each building. Since the largest fire truck takes smaller turns than a WB-67 any turning movements associated with a fire truck would be shown in the WB-67 movements. It should still be confirmed that the fire department has adequate accessibility to all sides of each building.

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
