## Comments:

Graves Engineering, Inc. (GEI) was on-site to observe construction of the road's drainage/stormwater management system. This site visit was conducted throughout the entire site. I observed the following:

- The silt fence and stump grindings between the eastern corner of Stormwater Management Area (SWMA) #1 and the property line were well-maintained.
- The jute matting between stations 8+00 and 9+00, as well as at the northern corner of SWMA #2, was in good condition.
- Three-quarter-inch crushed stone was stockpiled in the storage area as well as outside the right-of-way between stations 13+00 and 19+00.

Based upon visual observations only, the work observed today appeared to be consistent with the approved plans.
