The meeting was opened at 2:00 P.M. by Neal Crites. All members present.

The first order of business was the approval of minutes from meeting from November 4, 2020. Neal made motion to approve Jack 2nd all in favor approved 3-0.

The next order of business on Agenda: Abatements all approved.

The next order of business: Budget was discussed numbers do not include salaries. \$15,000 was added to \$866,000 based on new connections made last year.

Regarding CWMP-Planning Dept. to forward to DEP.

Don said new growth will stabilize Sewer Billing. Millbury's billing is based upon Sutton's flows.

Approval of Budget was given to Donald. All in favor. Final Budget will be to submitted in January.

Proposed Articles: Five weeks ago the actuator failed at the Sutton Sewer Facility. Don stressed the importance of having this on hand. It takes between 6-8weeks for a replacement valve to come in. This is a \$14,000 piece of equipment.

Upgrade needed on generator at Commerce Park. The replacement will be converted from Propane to Natural gas. Motion for Articles. Jack moved to put for Article to replace generator. Carl agreed, all in favor.

Article for March: Neal made motion to put aside \$60,000-\$80,000 for equipment replacement. Don to finalize numbers. Jack ok to move forward.

Sponsoring articles: To accept the Sewer Pump Station at 7.5 Wildflower Drive. Will determine if need to be through Tax Title or Imminent Domain. Put on Next Agenda. Don to write the article.

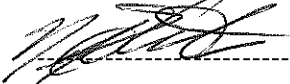
No Correspondence.

New Business: The proposed Wedgewood project on Armsby Rd on hold. The proposed Carwash - at Galaxy Pass is moving forward.

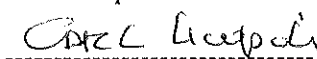
