The meeting was opened at 4:05 P.M. by Larry Wiersma.

The first order of business was to review and approve the minutes of 4-10-2014; Larry motioned to move the approval of the minutes. James moved the motion. Passes 3-0.

The next order of business was the commissioner's review on the sewer bylaws. Neal strongly recommended that the Sutton-Millbury municipal agreement discussion be waived at this time as they are not able to make any changes on the signed document. He stated that recommendations can take place but no physical changes can be made. The board was in agreement.

The next order of business was finalizing the bylaws. Donald recommended finalizing the bylaw's due to the bylaw committee meeting tomorrow night. James stated that he believes there are many grammatical mistakes and does not feel ready to finalize the bylaw. James gave a hand-out on his personal views and stated he would like them to be reviewed and taken into consideration before finalizing the bylaws. James also stated various personal recommendations to be added to the bylaws. Neal made a motion to move forward not referencing the IMA, which is not currently in the bylaws, and no reference to split systems between Manchaug and Wilkinsonville for rate structure. Anything that needs to be defined needs to be approved by the bylaw committee or attorneys. And finally the committee's duties and responsibilities be added to the bylaws. A few footnotes and grammatical errors need to be changed before the bylaw committee as well. Motion seconded by Larry. Motion passed 2-1 (James voted against).

James stated that he will be attending the town bylaw meeting tomorrow night as a private citizen, not as a sewer commissioner, to discuss his personal views and recommendations.


Next order of business: correspondence and old business.

- An abatement on a sewer bill due to a wrong reading from the water company. The abatement will need to be signed at the next sewer commissioners meeting.


New Business:
