Rigid Plastic

SPEAK WITH ATTENDANT BEFORE DUMPING

Plastic laundry baskets or plastic chairs

Plastic buckets (no metal handles or contaminates)

Plastic toys (without metal/screws/batteries)

NO Metal or Wood Attached

NO Plastic coat hangers

NO PVC, Pipe or Vinyl siding

NO bottles of any kind

Items longer than 3 ft. need to be cut

Paper & Paperboard

Printer paper

Cereal boxes, Soda boxes, Cracker boxes

Paper bags (No rope or plastic handles)

Wrapping paper (Not foil faced. No Ribbons or Bows)

NO Toilet paper

NO Tissue Paper (like Kleenex

NO Paper towels, Paper plates, Paper cups or Napkins

NO Cardboard

NO Styrofoam

Glass

Food quality only, rinsed of product, covers separated and sorted per their respective material.

NO Mirrors (See attendant)

NO Windows (See attendant)

NO Food or wax(candles) in the containers (These are bagged as trash)

NO Ceramics/Plates/Stoneware

Cans

Food Quality cans (Beer/Soda/Food/Clean Trays, etc.)

<u>NO</u> Food in the containers (Full/partially full containers are bagged as trash)

NO Paint cans

NO Coat hangers

NO Random pieces of metal

Other Metal Items → Scrap Metal Bin

Regular Plastic

Milk, Water, Juice bottles

Syrup, Ketchup or other condiments

Peanut butter jar

Margarine and butter tubs

Yogurt containers, Liquid dish soap

Shampoo and Conditioner bottles

Mouthwash bottles

Liquid laundry detergent

Soft drinks /Sport drinks /Water bottles

Liquid fabric softener

NO Food in the containers

NO Styrofoam or Straws

NO Packing peanuts

NO Medical supplies

NO Plastic bags, Wrap, Packaging or

Cling wrap

NO Plastics from electronics (See

attendant)

NO CDs, Video tapes, Cassettes

Cardboard

<u>Corrugated only</u> (Paperboard layer, squiggle layer, paperboard layer)

NO Waxed paper or waxed cardboard (Stock Cartons, Juice Cartons, Milk Cartons, etc. Please bag these with trash)
